



## Guide to Manuscript Collections | Women's Suffrage

### **1982.106 Campbell, W. P.**

The collection contains correspondence and personal papers concerning the first curator of historical collections of the Oklahoma Historical Society, William P. Campbell. It includes extensive material relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society. The collection includes materials for the National American Woman Suffrage Association.

### **1998.111 Catt, Carrie Chapman**

Contains a booklet from the Annual Convention of the National American Woman Suffrage Association, Washington, DC, February 11–17, 1904, with the text of an address by Carrie Chapman Catt.

### **1995.051 Cruce, Lee**

These are research files on Governor Lee Cruce compiled by Orben Casey during the writing of his thesis, "Governor Lee Cruce and his 'Righteous Crusade'", (M.A., University of Oklahoma, 1972). The collection contains folders on women's suffrage from 1911 and 1914.

### **Historic Oklahoma**

Historic Oklahoma is a vertical file of original materials. The collection is arranged alphabetically by topic and includes a biographical series.

### **1985.099 Korn, Anna L. B.**

The Anna L. B. Korn collection contains materials relating to women's rights and democratic politics. Included in the collection are postcards depicting women's suffrage, information regarding the organization Democratic Women of the State, and information on other women's organizations.

### **2013.468 Miller, Aloysius Larch**

The Aloysius Larch Miller Collection contains a certificate from the National American Woman Suffrage Association.
