

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
Pursuant To 36 CFR Section 800.6 (a)

Whereas, the Department of the Air Force has determined that demolition will have an effect upon Building 209, a property potentially eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f);

Now, therefore, the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

The Department of the Air Force will ensure that the following measures are carried out:

- The Department of the Air Force will submit to the Oklahoma SHPO at least two (2), 5"x 7" or larger black-and-white, archival-quality photographs depicting all four elevations of Building 209.
- The Department of the Air Force will submit to the Oklahoma SHPO a map clearly indicating the location of Building 209 in relation to surrounding buildings and structures.
- The Oklahoma SHPO shall consider the Historic Preservation Resource Identification Form already submitted as part of an Architectural/Historic Resource Survey of Tinker AFB to be sufficient written documentation.
- Documentation provided under stipulations 1 and 2 must be approved by the Oklahoma SHPO prior to the demolition of Building 209.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, evidence that the Department of the Air Force has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the demolition and its effects on historic properties, and that the Department of the Air Force has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic places.
