

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
Pursuant To 36 CFR Section 800.6(a)

Whereas, the Department of the Air Force has determined that replacement of test cell doors will have an effect upon Building 214, a property eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f) .

Now, therefore, the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

The Department of the Air Force will ensure that the following measures are carried out:

- The Department of the Air Force will submit at least four (4), 5" X 7" or larger black and white, archival quality photographs depicting " incell " and " outcell " views of the doors in both the open and closed position.
- The Department of the Air Force will submit to the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office a map clearly indicating the location of Building 214 in relation to surrounding buildings and structures.
- The Department of the Air Force will submit a brief narrative describing the building and engine repair history.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by the Department of the Air Force and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, evidences that the Department of the Air Force has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the replacement of the test cell doors and its effects on historic properties, and that the Department of the Air Force has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
