

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR PART 800.6(A)**

WHEREAS, the Town of Garvin has determined that the proposed purchase of land and church building, erection of a security fence, planning activities and development activity which will follow in Lot 4, Block 19, O.T. of the Town of Garvin, will have an effect upon the Garvin consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR part 800, regulation implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. part 470f); and


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Garvin and the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations


The Town of Garvin will ensure that the following measures are carried out:

All proposed construction activities at the site will be reviewed by the State Historic Preservation Officer to assure that the work meets the Secretary of the Interior's Standards.

Execution of the Memorandum of Agreement by the Town of Garvin and SHPO, is Evidence that the Town of Garvin has afforded the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation an Opportunity to comment on the Garvin Rock Church Project and its effects on historic properties And that the Town of Garvin has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic Properties.
