

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR PART 800.6(a)

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has determined that the marketing and sale of the HUD-acquired property, FHA Case Number: 421-211983, Property Address: 1804 NW 11th, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73106, will have an effect upon said property and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f); and


NOW, THEREFORE, HUD and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

STIPULATIONS:

HUD will ensure that prior to any sale or transfer of title of the property located at 1804 NW 11th, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73106, the Preservation Covenant (Attached as Appendix A) will be attached to the deed of subject property.




