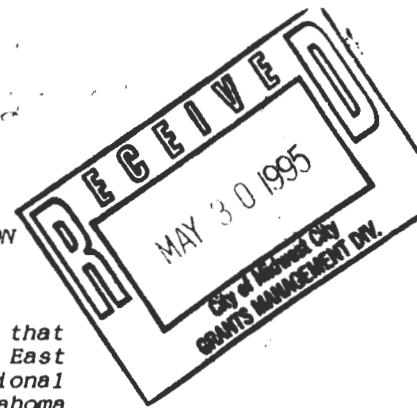


MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR § 800.6(a)



WHEREAS, the City of Midwest City has determined that demolition and reconstruction will have an effect upon 501 East Curtis Drive, a property eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f); and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Midwest City and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on historic properties.

Stipulations

The City of Midwest City will ensure that the following measures are carried out:

1. The property will be documented with a minimum of five 5x7 black and white photographs of the exterior.
2. A written narrative tracing the ownership of the house will be provided.
3. The Oklahoma SHPO will have final approval of all submitted documentation before the property is demolished.
4. All documentation shall be deposited with the Oklahoma SHPO.
5. The design of the replacement building must meet the approval of the Oklahoma SHPO. The new building shall be constructed with similar materials including color, scale, and roof form. The setback of the new building shall match that of the old.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by the City of Midwest City and the Oklahoma SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, evidence that the City of Midwest City has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the demolition and reconstruction and its effects on historic properties, and that the City of Midwest City has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
