MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Tulsa (City), the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) executed a Memorandum of Agreement on July 20, 1980, for redevelopment of the Greenwood-Brady Heights Historic District, <u>Tulsa</u>, Oklahoma; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to substitute the expertise and services of its Historic Preservation Support Group for the now defunct Tulsa Historic Preservation, Incorporated; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. Sec. 470f, as amended, 90 Stat. 1320) and Section 800.6(c)(4) of the Council's regulations, "Protection of Historic and Cultural Properties" (36 CFR Part 800), the City has now requested an amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 800.6 of the Council's regulations, representatives of the Council, the City and the Oklahoma SHPO have consulted and reviewed the proposed amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed that the undertaking will be implemented in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement ratified on July 20, 1980, as amended by the attached proposal and concurrence letter.
