

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
PURSUANT TO 36 CFR PART 800.6(A)

WHEREAS, the Department of the Air Force, Air Education and Training Command, Vance Air Force Base (Vance AFB) has determined that a project for modification of Building #129 will have an effect upon Building #129, a property eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, and has consulted with the Oklahoma State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 800, regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470f); and

NOW, THEREFORE, Vance AFB and the Oklahoma SHPO agree that the undertaking shall be implemented in accordance with the following stipulations in order to take into account the effect of the undertaking on the historic property.

STIPULATIONS

Vance AFB will ensure that the following measures are carried out:

Vance AFB shall ensure that Building #129, Vance Air Force Base is recorded in accordance with the requirements for Level #2 documentation for the Historic American Buildings Survey as detailed in the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines for Architectural and Engineering Documentation: HABS/HAER Standards (Originally published in the Federal Register, Vol. 48, No. 190, [Thursday, September 29, 1983], pp. 44730-34.) contained in Appendix "A" to this agreement. Vance AFB shall further ensure that this recordation shall be completed and accepted by the Oklahoma SHPO prior to the beginning of the renovation of Building #129. A completed set of the recordation shall be deposited with the Oklahoma SHPO and with the Enid Public Library.

Execution of this Memorandum of Agreement by Vance AFB and the Oklahoma SHPO, its subsequent acceptance by the Council, and implementation of its terms, evidence that Vance AFB has afforded the Council an opportunity to comment on the project for modification of Building #129 and its effects on historic properties, and that Vance AFB has taken into account the effects of the undertaking on historic properties.
